SUPER SWERTE RULES PCSO SILVER CUP

One of the greatest rivalries in Philippine horseracing history has just added another spectacular chapter in the recently concluded P4-million 2021 Philracom-PCSO at the San Lazaro Business and Leisure Park in Carmona, Cavite.

Billed as the Sunday Showdown, this installment of the Super Swerte-Boss Emong saga did not disappoint the racing public as the two protagonists were out to declare who's the best older horse in the land. With Edward Vincent "Don Edong" Diokno's Boss Emong (Dance City out of Chica Una) a slight favorite over rival Leonardo "Sandy" Javier Jr.'s Super Swerte (Art Moderne out of Faster Tapper) the stage was set for a breathtaking finish.

At the start of the 1750-meter journey, it was the fast-stepping Union Bell who dictated the pace with Boss Emong a close second and Super Swerte within striking distance in fifth. At the half-mile pole, Boss Emong was making a charge for the lead with Super Swerte also making his move inching closer to the leaders. With 600-meters remaining, it was clear that it was going to be a two-horse race with Boss Emong in command by about one length with Super Swerte just on the inside. It was around the last 200-meters when Andrew Villegas masterfully steered his mount from off the rail and moved toward the outside of the leader when Super Swerte responded with huge strides to level up on Boss Emong.

As they hit the wire, the Ruben Tupas trained Super Swerte took the plum and the P2.4-million top prize by a half-length over Boss Emong whose connections have to settle for the P800-thousand runner-up prize. Third place honors went to Union Bell (P400-thousand), then came Greatwall, Pangalusian Island and Princess Eowyn taking fourth to sixth, respectively.

Time of race was 1:50.6 (9'-23'-24'-25'-28).

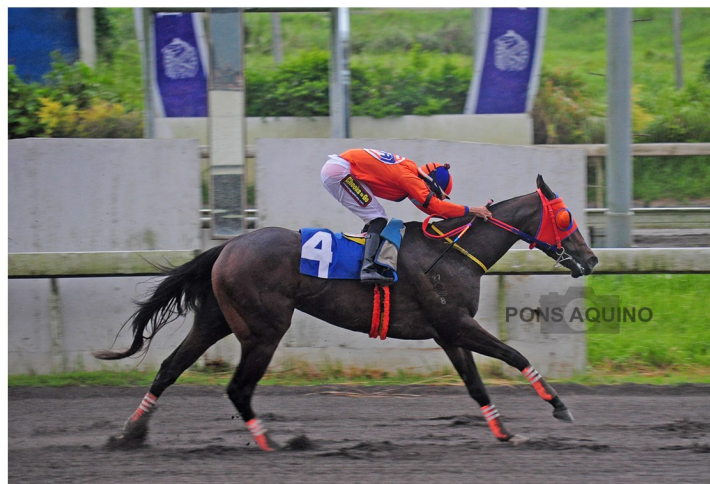
In the P1-million 2nd leg of the 2021 Philracom Juvenile Stakes series, Bell Racing's Radio Bell (Sakima out of Radioactive Love) trained by Donato Sordan with premier jockey Jonathan B. Hernandez on board exacted sweet revenge over first leg tormentor Gomezian (Hot Yoga by Sakima) in a speed challenge for the ages stopping the clock at 1:35.4 with clips of 18-24-25-28'.

At the start, it was clear that the two top protagonists will be going toe-to-toe battling it out for the win waiting for the other to falter. But the falter they were waiting for never came as the one-on-one affair went on until the last 100-meters where Radio Bell just had enough gas in the 1500-meter race to hold off the late charging Enigma Uno, with Gomezian-

having to settle for third, while Ballet Champion came in fourth.

The win gave Radio Bell's connections the P600-thousand prize that goes with the victory.

In the Philracom-sponsored PSA Stakes "Big Boss" James Anthony Rabano's Mommy Caring Striding Ahead out of On A Mission bred by the Esguerra Farms and Stud) traversed the 1600-meter journey unthreatened going wire-to-wire for the win and taking home the P300-thousand attached.

Runners-up honors went to Luke Skywalker, Tocque Bell, Money Changer and Arrabiata which came in second to fifth, respectively. "We are very thankful to everyone for a very successful holding of the 2021 Silver Cup , PSA Stakes and 2nd leg of the Juvenile Stakes series.

Horseracing is back on its feet so expect more exciting races in the coming days", Philracom Chairman Aurelio "Reli" de Leon said.

Basheirrou captures PCSO Maiden Race

It was just like a walk in the park for highly-touted, but relegated to only the second choice, Basheirrou in taking the 2021 Philippine Charity Sweepstakes Office Maiden Race last Sunday at the Santa Ana Park in Naic, Cavite.

At the onset, top choice Enigma Uno set the pace with the eventual winner well within striking distance and it was clear that the event was going to be a two-horse affair as the rest of the field was clearly outgunned by the two leaders.

With 600-meters remaining, the Rancho Sta. Rosa-owned, Ruben Tupas-trained and Melaine Habla-bred (Brig-and out of Allemeuse) chestnut colt masterfully ridden by Kelvin Abobo stretched his stuff to grab the lead and began to open up an insurmountable distance between him and all comers.

At the finish line, Basheirrou was like issuing a challenge to other two-year olds (for the upcoming 2nd leg of the Philracom Juvenile Stakes where equally top caliber young horses will compete like first leg winner GOMEZIAN and runner up RADIO BELL which will be on Nov 7 at the San Lazaro Business and Leisure Park) by stopping the clock at 1:17.4 (7'-21'-22'-26), seven lengths ahead of the nearest opposition, for the six and a half furlong journey and bringing home the top prize of P600-thousand for his connections.

Coming in second was Enigma Uno for P200-thousand followed by Tinago Falls (P100-thousand) and Hot Rot Hearts(P50,000).

MOMMY CARING tops PCSO Maiden Stakes Race

The Philippine Charity Sweepstakes Office sponsored 3YO Maiden Stakes produced no surprises as Mommy Caring (Striding Ahead out of On A Mission bred by the Esguerra Farm of businessman/sportsman Hermie Esguerra) of "Big Boss" James Anthony Rabano simply blasted the opposition away as the gates opened clocking 1:29.4(12'-23'-25'-28') in the 1400-meter race. Sharing the top plum of P600-thousand are trainer Ramon Nartea and jockey Lester de Jesus.

P225-thousand, P125-thousand and P50-thousand went to All Too Easy, Shanghai Sheikh and Stand By Me, respectively.

Meanwhile, in the Philippine Racing Commission-sponsored 3YO Maiden Stake for Local and Imported runners likewise did not surprise anyone as pre-race favorite Super Ninja (Ghostzapper out of Divine Beauty) owned by former basketball superstar Paolo de Villa Mendoza went unchallenged from gate to wire registering a time of 1:42.6(24'-24'-25'-28') for the 1600-meter journey and giving the connections the top purse of P600-thousand (trainer former jockey Norman Cagatin and jockey Pabz Cabalejo) at the San Lazaro Business and Leisure Park in Carmona, Cavite last Sunday.

She Is Rich Enough, Sir Prancealot and Tokyo Tokyo Rumba grabbed their share of the P1-million purse as runners-up (P225-thousand, P125-thousand and P50-thousand, respectively).
