

NUCLEAR BOMB DECLARED PCSO-PHILRACOM PGC WINNER

After a careful study of the video triggered by a protest filed by Super Swerte owner Leonardo "Sandy" Javier at the Philippine Racing Commission offices, it was declared that Gabriel Gaerlan's Nuclear Bomb was the rightful winner of the P10-millon Philracom-PCSO Presidential Gold Cup.

It will be recalled that Edward Vincent Diokno's Sky Shot went wire-to-wire in crossing the finish line first in the gruelling 2000m event with Nuclear Bomb by mere inches with Super Swerte coming in third and War Cannon in fourth.

However, the day after, Javier's camp lodged a formal protest of the results saying that the chances of their Super Swerte in winning was hampered by Sky Shot's coupled entry Boss Emong at the final stretch. This caused an investigation on the matter.

Thus, after a thorough review of the video footages of the race it was officially declared by the Philracom Board that Sky Shot's victory in the richest race in Philippine history be nullified and relegated to third and the official outcome of the race be rectified.

Therefore, the official order of finish in the PGC will read as Nuclear Bomb first winning P6-million, Super Swerte second, Sky Shot third, War Cannon fourth, Boss Emong fifth, Pangalusian Island sixth and Isla Puting Bato in seventh.

War Cannon rules PCSO 3YO Grand Derby

War Cannon blasted away the opponents in taking the 2021 PCSO 3YO Locally-Bred Grand Derby last Sunday, December 26, 2021 at the Saddle and Clubs Leisure Park in Naic, Cavite.

Breaking out of the gate second to last, War Cannon bided his time way behind stablemate Flattering You which was dictating the early pace of the race with Arrabiata in tow followed by Stayinthemoment and All Too Easy. At the half-mile pole, the Brigand-Ivanavinalot bay colt made his move relying on his vaunted come-from-behind style to move in contention for the win. By the time they reached the last 600-meters of the race, it was evident that the Melaine Habla-owned, Ruben Tupas-trained and Kelvin Abobo-mounted charger was not to be denied the victory as he was easing into the lead at that point with Arrabiata giving chase. As War Cannon hit the wire, he was 8-lengths clear of Arrabiata(Striding Ahead-Toyland) followed by Isla Puting Bato, then came All Too Easy while Tocque Bell settled for fifth.

By clocking 1:53.4 with clips of 13'-22-24'-25-28 for the 1800-meter distance, the Melaine Habla prized possesion took home P1.8-million. Arrabiata, Isla Puting Bato and All Too Easy had to contend themselves with P600-thousand, P300-thousand and P150-thousand, respectively.

PHILRACOM Chairman Aurelio "Reli" deLeon updated us by saying, "With the win by War Cannon, Melaine Habla's Brigand is now the year's leading stallion nosing out erstwhile leader Oh Oh Seven of the Esguerra Farms and Stud." "Esguerra Farms and Stud is still was ahead in the Breeder of The Year race while their broodmare Hayley Rebecca remains at the top of her own category," de Leon adds.
